Continue to love Jesus and make an effort to love Him more and more, without wanting to know anything else. 12 May the will of the heavenly Father be accomplished at all times, for all that He ordains is right. 13 The one who upsets and torments you is Satan; the One Who enlightens you is God 14 The soul that tends to humble and abase itself before its Lord cannot fail to recognize that all comes from God. 15 The grace of Jesus is the source of all the beautiful things that are happening to you. 16 Allow your divine Spouse to act in you and lead you by the paths He chooses. 17 Humble yourself before the Lord. 18 Be on your guard against the false humility which brings discouragement with it, for this leads infallibly to despair. 19 Thank the Lord that generous souls are not lacking, all intent on loving Jesus. 20 Make an effort to be more careful in observance of the divine precepts and of the duties belonging to your own state. 21 Unite your heart with the Heart of Jesus and be simple-hearted as He desires. 22 Make an effort to reproduce in yourself Jesus' own simplicity ... 23 Keep your heart far from earthly prudence and the shrewdness of the flesh. 24 Keep your thoughts pure, your ideas straightforward, and your intentions holy. 25 Let your will seek nothing other than God, His pleasure, His glory, and His honor. 26 Let us look at ourselves in Jesus, our mirror, in Jesus who led a hidden life. 27 Don't be daunted by the cross. 28 Tribulations and trials have always been the heritage and the portion of chosen souls. 29 Help yourself by reading holy books this reading provides excellent food for the soul. 30 In prayer and meditation it is we who speak to the Lord, while in holy reading it is God Who speaks to us 31 The Lord generally makes use of secondary causes for the fulfillment of His plans and indeed this is the way He usually acts.

With humble reverence, with purity of faith, with repentance and love, and the determination that will help to bring me to salvation I place myself in your presence. Padre Pio urged us to seek You always in all things. Grant that your Servant Pio may be the sure guide that leads me to You and through You to the Father.

Thursday - Lord Jesus, with reverence, gratitude, and adoration, I recognize Your loving presence in my life and its power to transform me. Padre Pio sought that transformation every moment of his life through his intimate relationship with You.
